Programme	GRADUATE COURSE – ENGINEER OFFICER
Qualifications Gained	MCA Officer of the Watch Certificate of Competency, STCW '95 Short Courses.
Entry Requirements	Applicants must hold a relevant Mechanical Engineering Degree or be a time served Engineer. Applicants will be required to apply for an Initial Letter of Assessment for sea time analysis by the Maritime & Coastguard Agency (MCA). Prospective Trainees must pass an Industry Standard ENG.1 Medical Examination.
Course Structure	A total of 3 phases combining sea time and college.
Total Course Duration	Approximately 1½ years dependent on sea time required.
Sea Time Included	A minimum of 6 months sea time to be completed within duration of course, however this may change depending on the type of Degree and the requirements of the MCA.
Colleges Available	Glasgow College of Nautical Studies South Tyneside College Warsash Maritime Academy
Leave / Holidays	Leave allocated within Sea Phases.
Start Date	August and January each year.
Training Allowance	At College £170 per week
	At Sea £120 per week

PHASE	COURSE STRUCTURE
Phase 1	College – Commence MNTB Workshop Skills course and Level 3 VQ. STCW'95 Short Courses including Fire Fighting, Elementary First Aid and Personal Survival Techniques.
Phase 2	Sea Phase – Completion of Training Portfolio by means of practical tasks and written reports, working towards Level 3 Merchant Vessel Engineering.
Phase 3	College – Preparation work for MCA Oral Examination and Advanced Safety Courses.
